Halloween Dirt Cups

What you need:

- ◇ 2 cups milk (cold)
- ◇ 1 package instant chocolate pudding (4-serving size)
- ◇ 8 oz. whipped topping (frozen, such as Cool Whip, thawed)
- ◇ 1 1/2 cups sandwich cookies (such as Oreos, crushed)

Directions:

- ◇ Whisk together milk and instant pudding for two minutes, until pudding is completely dissolved. Let stand 5 minutes to thicken.
- ◇ Stir in frozen whipped topping and 1/2 cup of the crushed cookies.
- ◇ Spoon into 10 cups.
- ◇ Sprinkle remaining crushed cookies over the pudding mixture. Top with 2 gummy worms.
- ◇ Chill until ready to serve.
